Scam / Fraud Alert

Jernigan Trucking and Adam True's Country Market located in Robertson County Tennessee reported to the Sheriff's Office that they had received calls at their business from a person claiming to be an employee of the Robertson County Sheriff's Office collecting donations for the Robertson County Youth Prevention Services. The caller is soliciting money for a drug awareness manual for the youth of Robertson County. Once the victim agrees to donate money, the caller sends a pick up person to the location to receive the money and give a receipt.

Suspect Vehicle: A large white panel van, having the word "Photo" on the side along with some other writing was that smaller and could not be read by the victim.

Suspect: White Male, approximately 5 feet 10 inches in height, clean shaven, Stocky Build believed to be in his 30's.

Beware / SCAM The Robertson County Sheriff's Office does not solicit money by phone or any other means. The Robertson County Sheriff's Office publishes this release to warn the citizens of Robertson County that any attempt to solicit money on its behalf is unauthorized and is nothing more than a SCAM.
